## Criteria:

1. Candidate must be eligible to graduate in June 2017
2. Candidate must be nominated by a member of the graduating class
3. Candidates must be earning a min. overall avg. of 75% in their graduating year
4. Candidates must be active participants in co-curricular program. Volunteer work and exceptional community involvement will be also be considered.

Administration will review all completed forms and selected a min. of 6 candidates whose name will be on the ballot for the position of valedictorian. The vote will be held during the first week of June.
